The Canaveral Port Authority is also a special taxing district; however it hasn’t been used in 30 years. The business community is looking for leaders who understand the importance of sound fiscal management - protecting revenue streams and managing debt - as necessary to avoid the need to levy taxes on the people of Brevard County.

“Robyn is focused on the long-term viability of the Port’s main revenue sources,” states McIntyre. “Her commitment to smart, managed growth makes her the right choice for District 5.”
